Likewise, every student has a responsibility to contribute to that environment.**

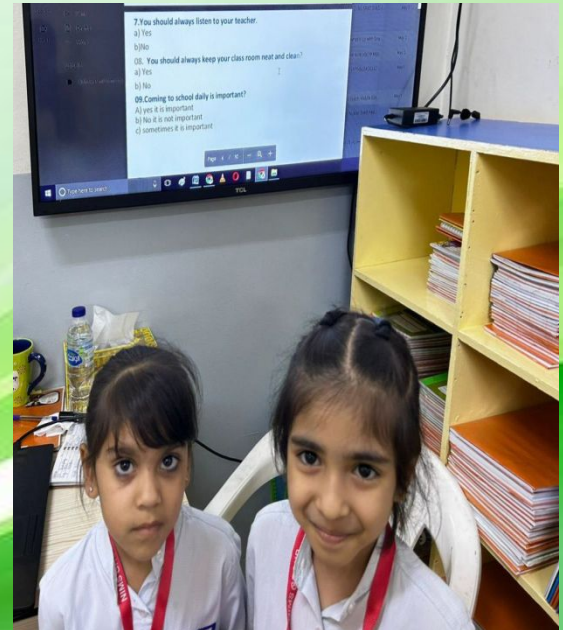
