World Ocean Day 2020

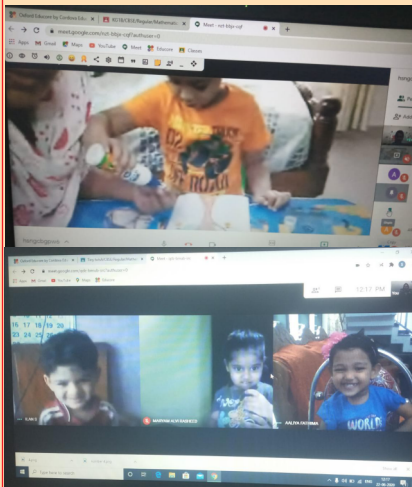

From the Principal's Desk



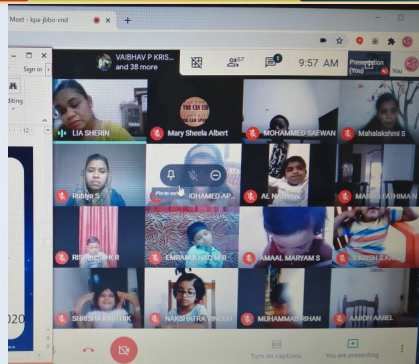
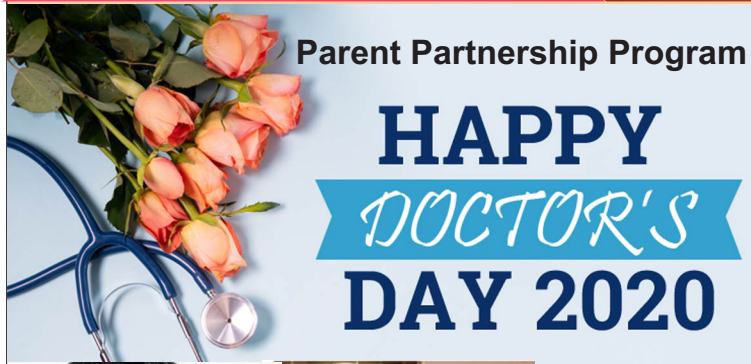
