FEE PAYMENT POLICY

Fees will be collected on Monday to Friday from 08.00 am to 1.00 pm and 02.00 pm to 04.00 pm. (Saturday: 09.00 am to 1.00 pm)

Failure to pay the fee dues on time entitles the school to collect the entire fees in advance for the next academic year before commencement; of classes. Default of fee dues more than three times in a year could result in refusal to admit the student for the next academic year. Notwithstanding the above, a Transfer Certificate (TC) would be issued only after all fee dues are settled with the school.




