



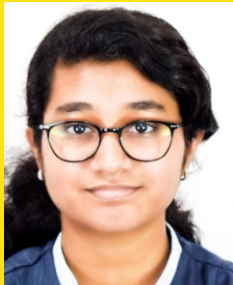

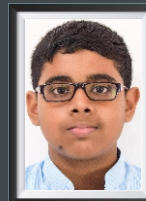

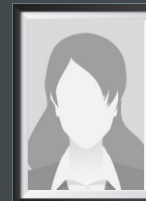

Dear Parents,

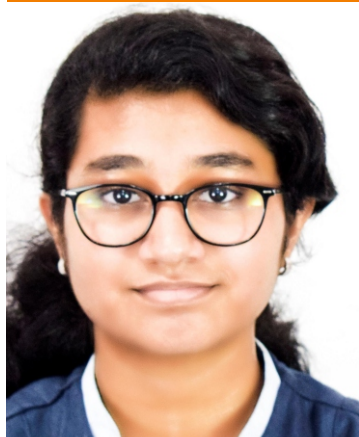

With the blessing of Almighty ,the event became a huge success.

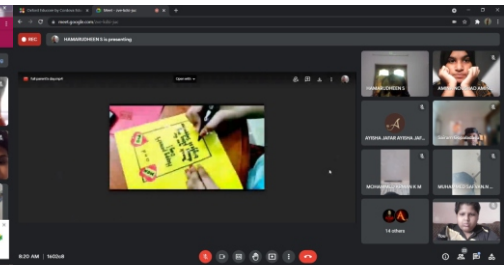
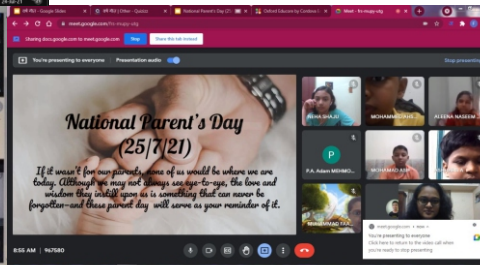
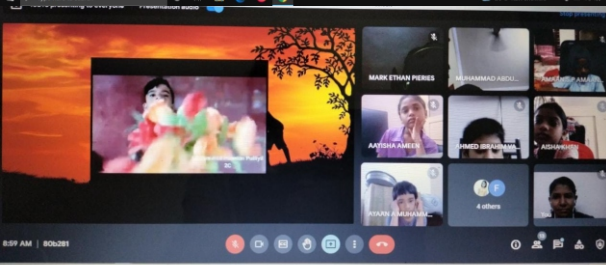
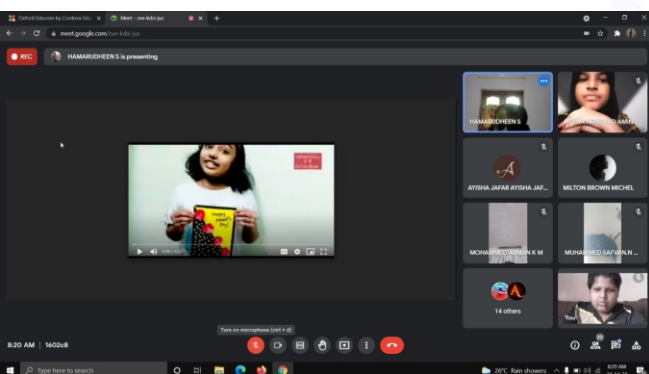

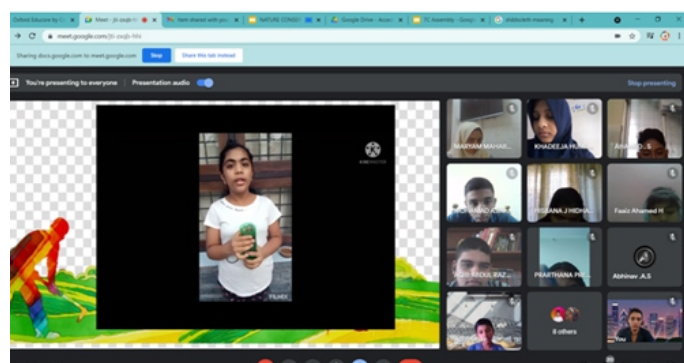
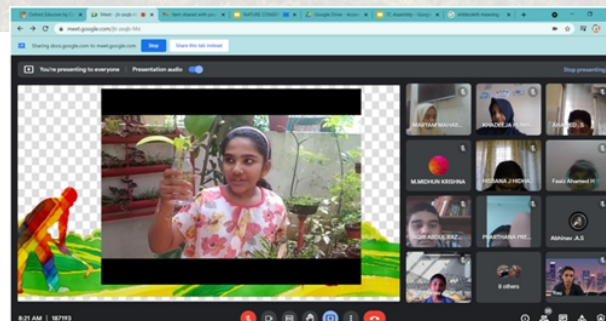
World Nature Conservation Day

our students from grades 8 to 12 have given us a good awareness about the importance of conserving our mother nature and also the tips to apply in our daily life to conserve and preserve our environment.

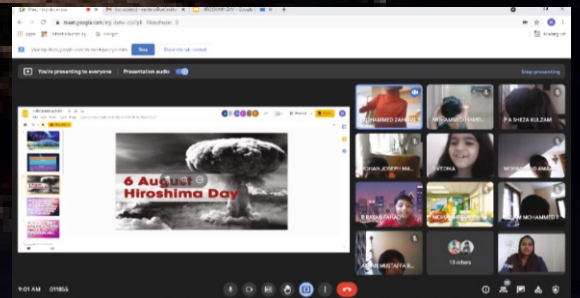
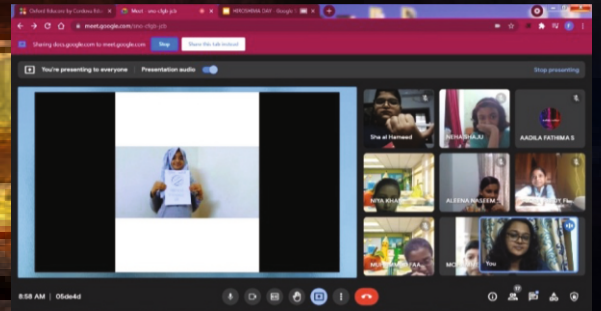
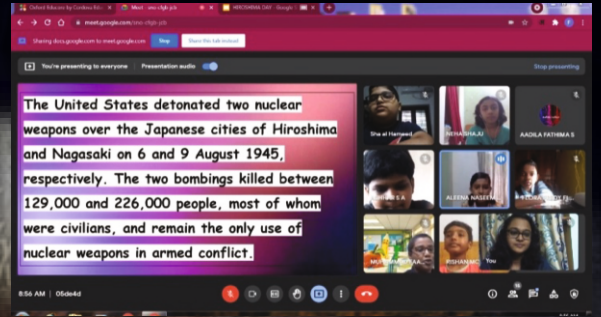


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HIROSHIMA NAGASAKI DAY

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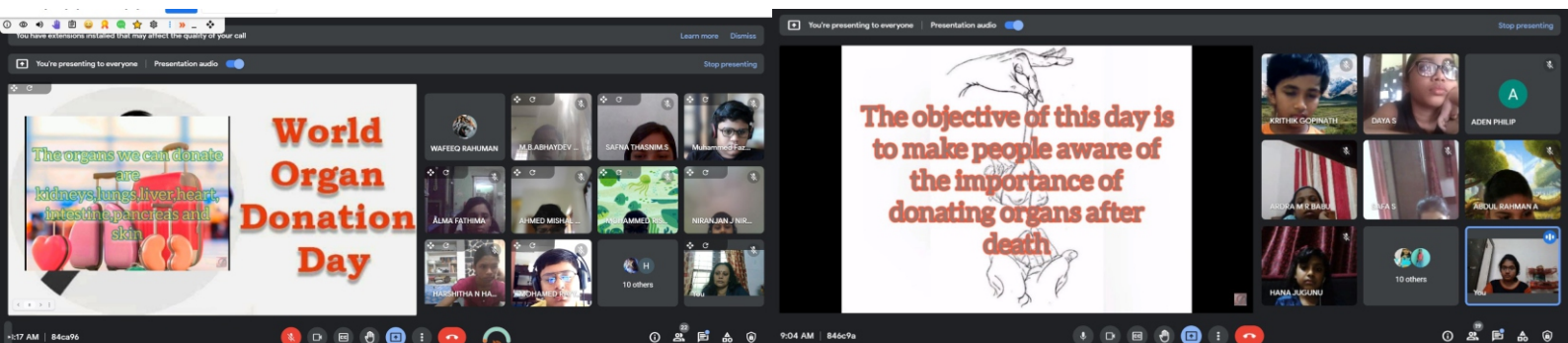


World organ day is observed every year on 13th August. The main aim of the day is to spread awareness about organ donation and to clear misconceptions related to donating organs.

healthy organs after their death to those who are in need.

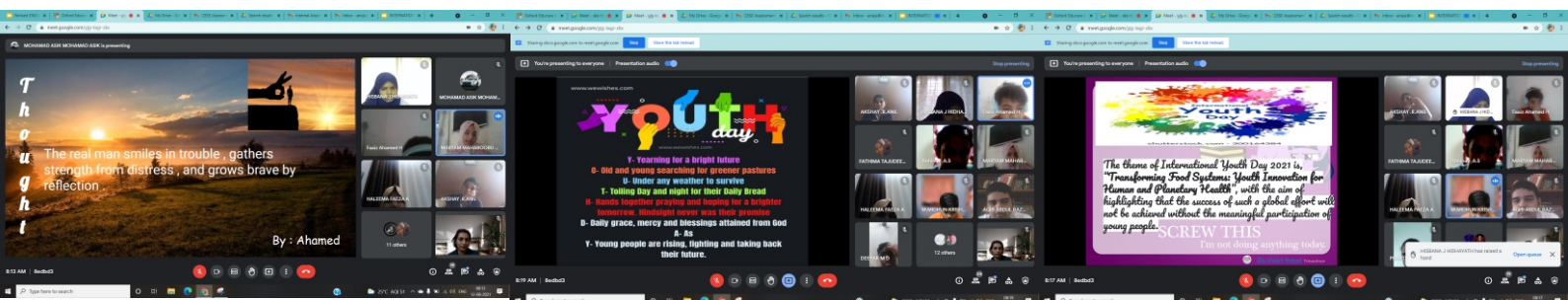
A special virtual assembly was organised on 16th August where the teachers briefed students about the significance of the day. PPTs were shown to the classes from grade 1 to grade 12.

INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATIVE LEARNING ON CULINARY SKILLS

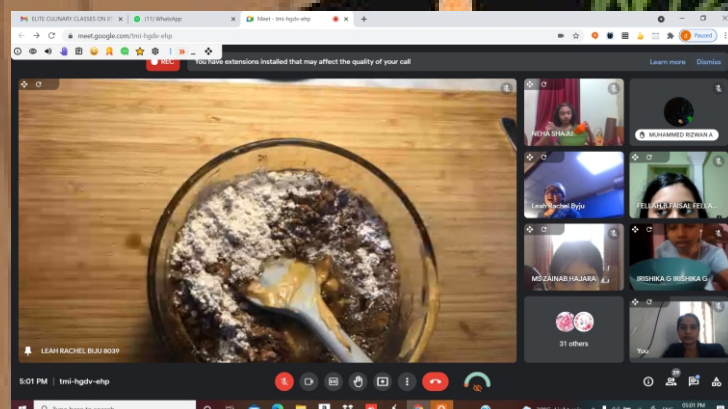
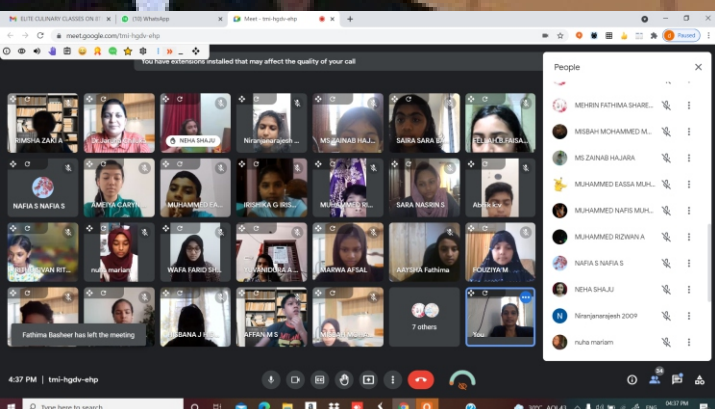

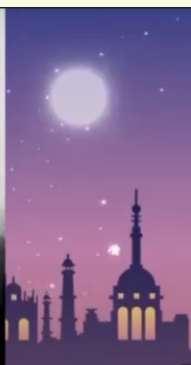
Onam & Muharam

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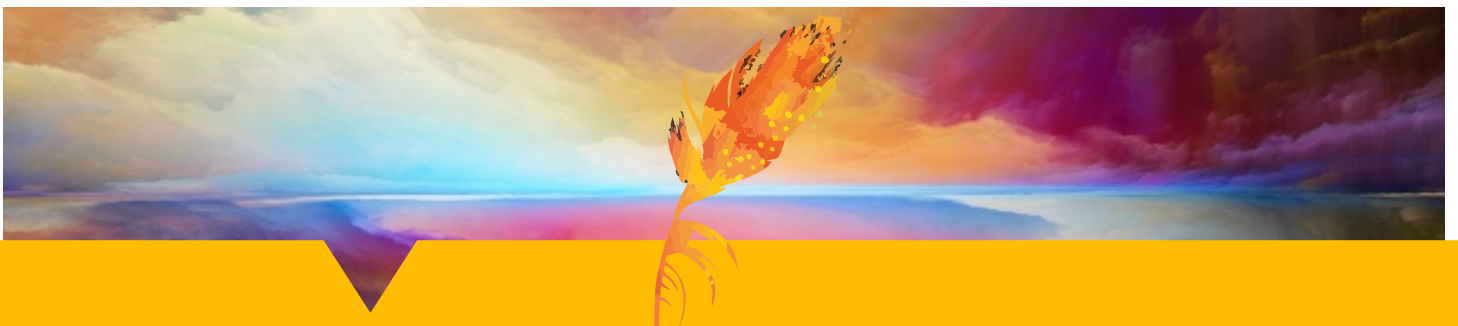
WORLD *Forgiveness* DAY

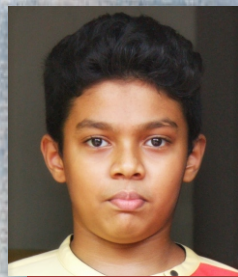

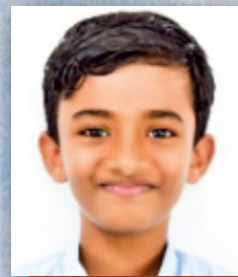
