

With the blessing of Almighty ,the event became a huge success.









our students from grades 8 to 12 have given us a good awareness about the importance of conserving our mother nature and also the tips to apply in our daily life to conserve and preserve our environment.


On Day 1 Home science students described the principles of cooking, pre-preparation methods and demonstrated pre-preparation method. And also, they demonstrated two recipes.
